Accommodation, the conference dinner (Thursday), and the poster sessions will be at St Edmund Hall <https://goo.gl/maps/4kjhde24JyN2>.

St Edmund Hall is very easy to get to by public transport. If you come by train or bus (to Gloucester Green), St Edmund Hall is a short taxi ride from either the bus or the rail station; though unless you have vast amounts of baggage, walking may be simpler (15 mins from the bus station, 25 minutes from the rail station).

If you are considering driving, bear in mind that parking in Oxford is very limited and expensive. You will probably be best using Oxford's "park & ride" system, where you can park for up to 72 hours (i.e. for the whole length of the meeting).
